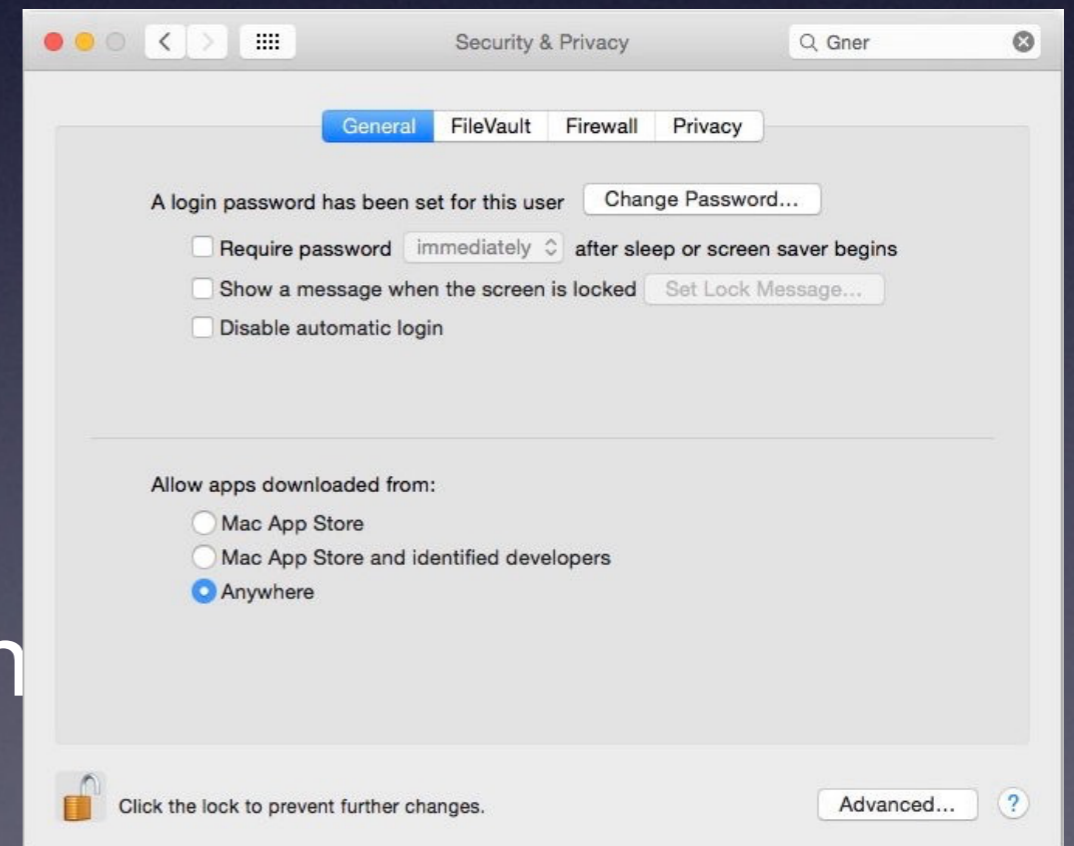

- ✓ KeePassX 

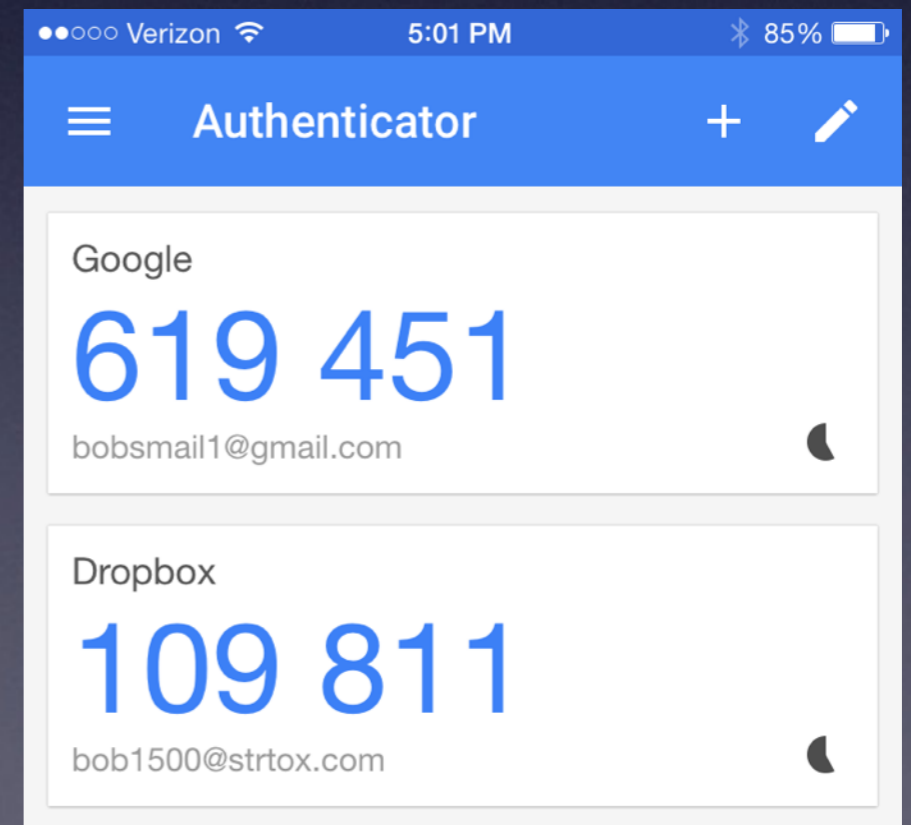
2-Factor Authentication

✓ Apple ID - sends temporary PIN to SMS or iOS

- Facebook



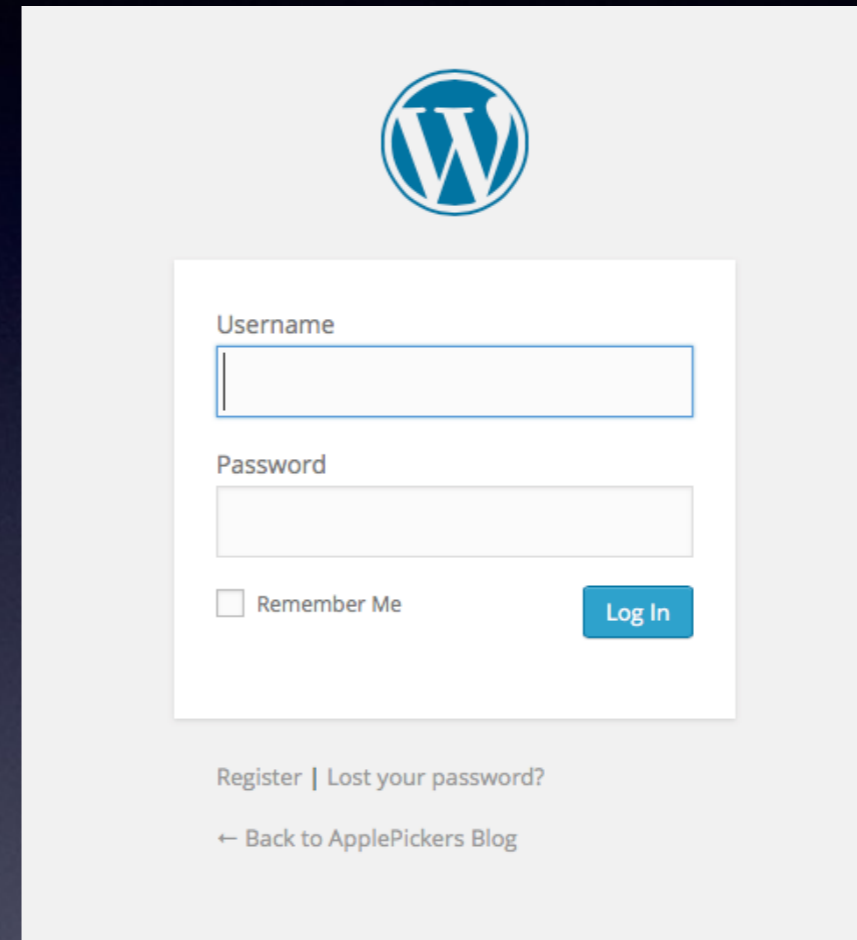
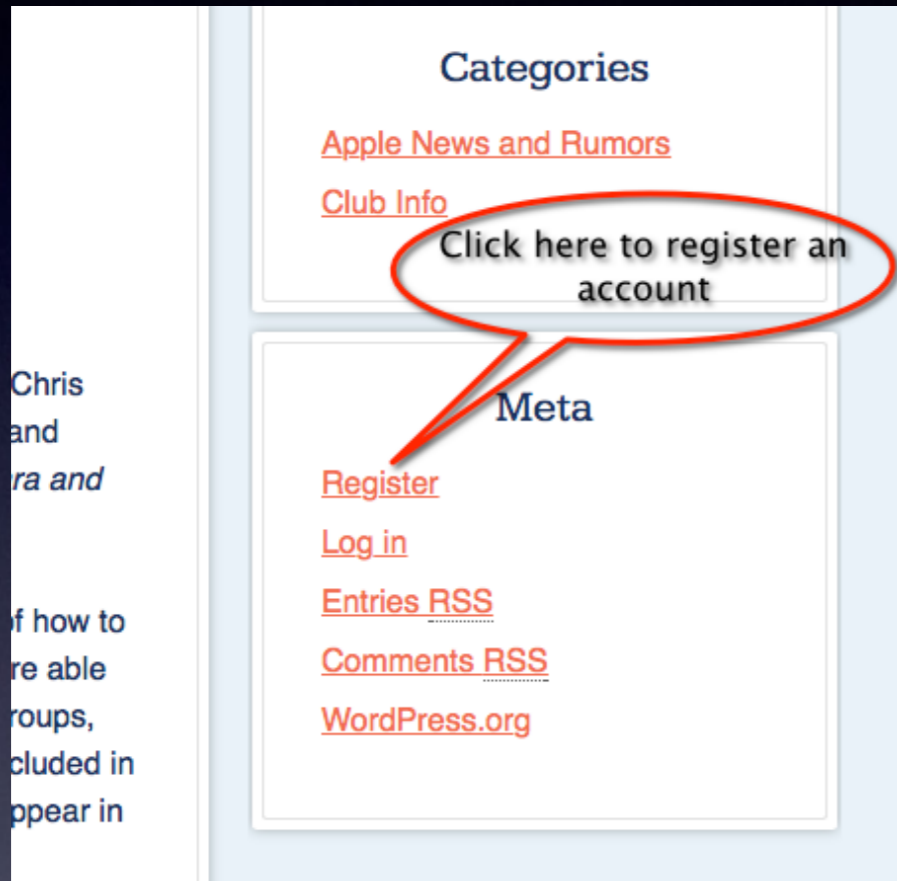
